College Profile

Government College Sultanpur (Farrukhnagar) Gurugram was established in the year 2019 by the government of Haryana to cater the demands of student community in the remote and rural areas of Farrukhnagar. It has a lush green campus sprawling across 8.5 acres of land. The college is located in the Jhanjhrola Khera Road and at just 3.25 km away from Sultanpur National Park- one among the only two national parks of Haryana.

The college was being run in a make shift building of village secretariat and government school of Sultanpur till September 2023 and its building was formally inaugurated by the then Chief Minister of Haryana on 7th March 2024.

Having started its journey with the first batch having the enrollment of just 48 students, the college is imparting the education to more than 500 students coming from various blocks of Gurugram districts and even from the neighboring district like Jhajjar and Rewari.

By imparting analytic, value-based education the college has acquired a reputation of excellence in a very short span of time. The Principal, the members of college fraternity, the ministerial staff and the support staff work tirelessly to make the college a coveted and sought-after institution for higher learning.

Academic courses

The college is affiliated with Gurugram University, Gurugram. The college offers Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com) programs. With student strength of more than 500, most of whom come from rural background. The college is committed to provide quality education and nurturing the talent of all the students.

Campus / Infrastructure

Govt College, Sultanpur, (Farrukhnagar), Gurugram is a premier higher education institution of Government of Haryana having a lush green campus sprawling across 8.5 acres having double storied building well designed to cater the academic and other extracurricular needs of the institution. There is adequate number of classrooms and laboratories to accommodate the students and make their learning more conducive. Besides classrooms and laboratories, adequate infrastructure like sports ground having the approximate area of 3.5 acres, multipurpose hall with the facilities of attached green rooms and multiple entries, canteen building and library is available for overall development of the students.

Classrooms: 20 classrooms equipped with the white boards are of different sizes are well lit.

Laboratories: Separate labs are there where practical (as per prescribed syllabus) can be conducted.

Networking: Wired/wireless LAN to provide high-speed internet facilities is there in the college. Total 10 computers are in college on record to meet the needs of students as well as administration. The college authorities are communicating with higher authorities to get the entire campus wi-fi enabled.

CCTV Cameras: There are a total of 18 cameras to provide a safe and secure atmosphere for all.

Infrastructure for Cultural Activities

To organize regular cultural activities, the following infrastructure supports the college effectively: a multipurpose hall with attached green rooms facilitates indoor events. In addition to this hall, the spacious college courtyard, which includes a permanent stage, also serves as a vital space for hosting various extracurricular activities.

Sports: The college promotes sports and physical well-being under the guidance of Mr. Dinesh Bera. It has a 3.5-acre sports ground and is equipped with facilities for games like cricket, volleyball, badminton, and athletics. Students regularly participate in practice sessions and inter-college events, reflecting the college's commitment to well-rounded development.

Facilities

To facilitate the students to have more conducive learning environment in the college, the following facilities are being provided to them-

1. **Library**

- Library is flourishing under the able guidance of Ms Lamha Bano, consisting of more than 500 books of various subjects ranging from Commerce, History, Hindi, English, Mathematics, and Political Science. Besides the subjects taught in the college, study material pertaining to competitive examinations is also available in the college library. The students are given the facility to get these books issued for 14 days.
- Besides the study material, library premise is also having the reading area witnessing regular footfall of students who find the area most suitable to sit and study in a calm atmosphere.

2. **Special Facilities for Girl Students:**

- Girls Common Rooms: Girls common room is an exclusive area for the female students of the college, which is instituted with the intent to allow the students to take a personal space after a long day of classes. The college recognizes the importance of students connecting and socializing with their peers, for which the common room has been equipped with necessary arrangements.
- Extension lecture: To make the girls aware of the proper nutrition and self-care, extension lectures are organized time to time in which experts deliver their lecture and have a curiosity solution session for the girls as well.
- Self-defense workshop: Such workshops are also organized in the college to give the girl students a hands-on training and thereby the college strives to enable them to become even stronger.

3. **Potable Drinking Water:**

- Facilities pertaining to potable drinking water has always been on the top priority of the college. College has made the alternative arrangements in the days when it doesn't have the proper water supply.

4. **ICT facilities for smooth conduct of administration:**
 - College provides the Wi-fi enabled computer systems for smooth conduct of administrative works.
5. **Garbage Disposal System:**
 - The college is equipped with sufficient number of dustbins placed in almost every block of the college. Students are made aware to inculcate hygienic practices and take proper care of the cleanliness in the campus.

Placement Cell

The Placement Cell, Govt. Women's Cell

Commerce Club

The Commerce Club, under the convenorship of Ms. Pooja Kumari and with active support from members Ms. Seema and Ms. Anupma, aims to enhance students' academic and professional skills through interactive, knowledge-driven events and activities related to commerce and business.

On 22nd March 2024, the club successfully organized an Online State-Level Quiz Competition, which witnessed participation from 126 students representing 27 colleges across Haryana. The quiz tested their knowledge through 30 multiple-choice questions to be answered in 30 minutes, with top positions secured by students from Gurugram, Sirsa, and Sector-14 Gurugram.

Students from our college also participated in creative and analytical events such as "**Sketch It Out**" (Logo Design) and **Group Discussions**, displaying their innovation and critical thinking abilities. Earlier in the academic year, the club hosted a **Resume Building Workshop**, equipping participants with essential job-readiness and professional development skills.
